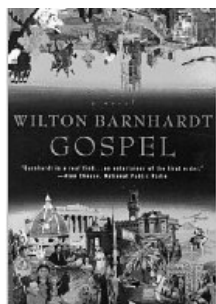
Wednesdays at 6:45 p.m.

concerns the search for a lost first-century gospel of the Bible, a document that could shake the foundations of Christianity.

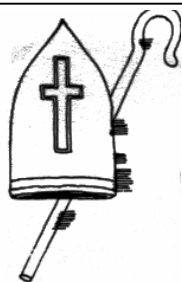
